oppose hb3962 – preserve oregon's tourism industry

This legislative session has seen multiple challenges to our Transient Lodging Tax (TLT) funding. **HB3962** proposes a fundamental change to the definition and distribution of the Transient Lodging Tax (TLT) as established by the Oregon Legislature in 2003 that clearly outlined a 70/30 split: **70% of TLT revenue dedicated to tourism promotion, marketing, and facility development**, and **30% allocated for unrestricted municipal use**.

HB 3962 would significantly expand the scope of the 70% restricted portion to now include **public safety services** (such as police, fire, and search and rescue) and community infrastructure projects (including water, sewer, and sidewalks)—a shift that undermines the very foundation and intent of the original statute. Once TLT dollars are redirected toward these generalized services, they will not return to their intended purpose. This diversion threatens the long-term sustainability of Oregon's tourism economy.

Travel Salem is strongly opposed to HB3962 because we know that <u>TLT is essential in marketing to and serving visitors</u> who in turn contribute to the economic prosperity of our regions. Please help us protect the integrity of TLT by <u>submitting letters of opposition</u>, and sharing your story with the House Committee on Revenue (listed below). 
